### 3. These are not entirely vegan/vegetarian but they have good vegan/vegetarian options on their menu that's worth a try like

- Red Dragon – 332 Cửa Đại – Their vegan fresh rolls with black sesame sauce is my favorite here, check their vegetarian/vegan set on the menu, you will absolutely love it!

### 4. And for a good cup of coffee, we recommend:

- 145 Espresso Café – super nice people that run this little place – very good coffee beans, best quality of coffee for the areas around Cam Thanh and Cam Chau

The farm features a picturesque fort that provides a wonderful photo opportunity. Moreover, the farm produces organic black rice that is used in our kitchen.
